Scholarship Information

Criteria:

- The applicant/recipient must be a member of the St. Andrew's Society of the Inland Northwest or one of its affiliates. In the case of an applicant under age 18, at least one parent must be a member of the Society or one of its affiliates.
- Scholarships will be in the nature of financial assistance to members who want to improve their skills and/or knowledge in their particular area of interest in Scottish culture, e.g. dancing, music, genealogy, history or language.
- Scholarship requests may be submitted at any time during the year.
- Preference will be given to applicants who at the time of the award do not intent to leave the Eastern Washington/Northern Idaho area, and who will therefore be able to further the Scottish cultural life of the area through the activities funded by the Society.
- Awardees are required to submit an article to the Society's newsletter, the *Thistle Epistle*, reporting their experiences and what they learned at the school, workshop or seminar they attended.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the school, workshop or seminar for tuition fees. If the applicant pays tuition before being awarded a scholarship, he/she may seek reimbursement by supplying proof of payment to the Scholarship Committee.
